The difficult task of setting tuition and fees to meet the ongoing needs of Loyola College Prep and its staff has been ongoing over the past few months. When determining tuition, we try to keep a balance between affordability for our families and the strategic needs of our school. **Your Loyola Board of Directors has voted and accepted to make no changes to the tuition and fee schedule for the upcoming 2019-20 school year.** Your Board at Loyola recognizes that educational costs can be an impediment to families choosing our school. Our hope is that the cost of education does not deter any family who wishes to send their child (children) to Loyola. ***Please call and inquire about Financial Assistance, and we will certainly work tirelessly to accommodate your financial circumstances.***

Below is the Loyola tuition and fee structure for the 2019-20 school year.

* Activity Fee Includes: Accident Insurance, Yearbook, Athletic Fee, Tech Fee, Student ID, Style Show, Parent Association Dues


In the 2018-19 budget, the actual cost to educate one student at Loyola College Prep next year is estimated at **\$12,500**. This difference between the cost and the tuition that is paid is known as "the financial gap". We hope to convey to each of you that we approach the budget with a sense of caution and stewardship. We work hard in

fundraising to help with "the financial gap", in managing school investments, and in creating non-tuition revenue in order to keep tuition at levels that are manageable.
